Choir vestry windows repairs appeal.

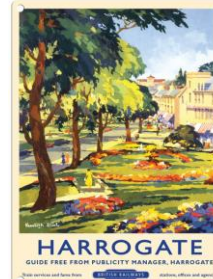
The choir vestry windows work cost £960. Thanks to
